


How to access your Cloud Stop Motion student account


If your school has an Organization Account with Cloud Stop Motion, your teacher or the Cloud Stop Motion administrator will give you your login details (organization name, user name and password). If you don't have these login details please contact your organization to request them.

1. Go to <https://app.cloudstopmotion.com/student-login>





2. Enter your School/Organization Name (this will need to be the exact name that your school has used to set up their account)
3. Enter your username and password.
4. Click Sign in

Cloud Stop Motion Requirements

Cloud Stop Motion is compatible with most modern browsers, but not all, so please check this list before.

Chromebooks: Latest version of Chrome - fully supported

macOS: The latest version of all modern browsers - Safari, Chrome etc. - are all fully supported.

Windows: The latest version of all modern browsers - Chrome, Firefox, Opera, Brave etc - are all fully supported. The newest version of Edge (Chromium) is fully supported.

iOS: Safari on iOS 11+ is supported. (Earlier versions can't access the camera.)


Unfortunately Chrome, or other webviews (such as the Facebook browser) can't access the camera so you can't capture images, but you can watch and edit existing projects.

Android: Latest version of Chrome for Android is fully supported

Linux: The latest version of all modern browsers - Chromium, Firefox etc. - are all fully supported.

You can use Cloud Stop Motion on any modern connected device, Windows machines, Macs, iPads, tablets, smartphones. If your device does not have a suitable camera, you can connect a webcam, (most webcams will work as long as they stream a live image to the device).

If you do not have a webcam or can't get a live image in Cloud Stop Motion you can import images from your computer or phone instead. Just click on the Import Images icon on the Camera Tab.

If your school does not have an organization account yet, please let them know about Cloud Stop Motion - they can set up a school account for free with unlimited users.

Alternatively you can set up your own individual account for Cloud Stop Motion, which will be unrelated to an organization. (A small account is free!)
